Uniform Reminders:

1. Underneath your uniform we recommend wearing your dry-fit parade band shirt and shorts.
2. Please have a jacket or hoodie to go over your uniform while you are eating.
3. Compression sleeves are recommended to help with the itchiness of the sequins.
4. Please ensure that all of the uniform is inside of the garment bag and that the bag is zipped securely. We do not want any spillage of capes outside of the bag.
5. No running, horsing around, or inappropriate behavior while in uniform. This includes when you are in your dry-fit. You are representing Snider and we expect excellence from you.
6. **Put your uniform bag back in numerical order!**

3. Bag to keep your stuff in (marching band students are allowed to have bags at the football game)
